The Fund Awards categories were designed with performance in mind (i.e. financial investment returns to the member), and with intention to balance short-term momentum and longer-term consistency.

1-year period : recognise funds that successfully navigate the immediate market and economic landscape.

3-year period : recognise consistent performance, filters out temporary deviations and favour recent performance without overly weighting past performance.

House categories : recognise consistency by a provider across their PRS fund offerings.
